Carman's dress code policy is designed to encourage neatly-groomed students and to create an atmosphere that promotes modesty, integrity, and learning. The principal has the final word regarding interpretation of the guidelines below. Unless otherwise noted, uniforms should be purchased through approved vendors. Skorts	Skorts are to be in khaki, navy blue, or plaid color (plaid color 80 only), with a modest hemline (past fingertips).
	These come with built-in shorts for privacy.
Jumpers	K through 4 <sup>th</sup> grades may wear modest-length navy blue, khaki, or plaid (plaid # 80) jumpers with the embroidered

Nails, Jewelry,	Clear nail polish only.
& Make-up	No jewelry.

Backpacks &	Plain backpacks and lunchboxes with simple colors and patterns are preferred.
Lunchboxes	Wheeled backpacks are not permitted
Friday: Dress	Students have the privilege of wearing denim shorts or jeans with their Carman polo on Fridays.
Down	• Shorts/jeans are to be selected to meet the same guidelines as the uniform shorts/pants. They must
